#### How to register:

Step One: Visit www.homeweb.ca and click 'Sign Up'.

<u>Step Two</u>: Type your company name and click 'Find it!' Select the correct company from the list provided. Health Services Invitation Code: NBA552. Enter information into the required fields, choose an email and password, and click 'Next Step'.

<u>Step Three</u>: Let us know how you are covered by Homewood, (e.g. through your organization or the organization of a family member), and let us know your relationship to the organization (e.g. employee, spouse, dependent, etc.). Submit the additional information required and click 'Sign Up' at the bottom of the page.
